NO PERMIT REQUIRED! (Naugatuck residents only, with proof of address)

Regular Hours of Operation: Thursdays & Saturdays from 8am-2pm

Additional Hours: Tuesdays April 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025, from 11am-7pm

Off Peak/Winter Schedule: Bulk Trash will be open on the 1st & 3rd Saturdays of January, February, and March, and will fully reopen on Saturday, March 29. Bulk Trash will close on December 20, 2025. Winter days & hours are weather permitting, and subject to change.

Mattresses, Box springs, Electronics, Brush, Christmas Trees, Leaves in Paper Bags, Automotive Batteries, Motor Oil, Oil Filters, Antifreeze, Hydraulic & Heating Oil, Transmission Fluid, Cooking Oil & Grease, Cardboard, Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Glass and Plastic Bottles, Food Containers, Metal Food & Beverage Cans, Aerosol Cans, Juice & Paperboard Cartons, Juice Boxes, Junk Mail, Boxboard (Cereal style cardboard) Office Paper, Books, Fluorescent Bulbs, Rechargeable Batteries, Fire Extinguishers, Paint, Scrap Metal.
