Section 1 General Information and Requirements

1.1 General Information

The Borough of Naugatuck (BON) seeks Proposals and expressions of interest from vendors with proven experience in the refurbishing of Vac-Con Truck

1.2 Description of Work

Major items to be replaced:

1. Complete 3-stage Vacuum Blower assembly, including drive motor and coupler.
2. Complete FMC water pump rebuild.
3. New water pump drive belts, and water pump drive bearings.
4. Complete new style Debris Body 9 cubic yards, including rear door, gaskets, ss filter screens, and inlet assembly.
5. Replace front driveline and central hydraulic system drive belts.
6. Replace rodder hose, hose reel bearings, swivel joint union and all water ball valves.
7. Change complete hydraulic system oil and all filters.
8. Change auxillary engine oil and filters.
9. Replace all Kanoflex 8" rubber hoses and clamps, with new hose ends included.
10. Replace complete Vac-con unit wire harness, with modular weather-tite connectors.
11. Repair articulating front hose reel and install new hydraulic outrigger leg assembly.
12. Replace high pressure and low pressure relief valves in water system.
13. Replace telescopic boom seals.
14. Misc items to be included as needed, including deck repairs, mud flaps and lights.
15. Complete Paint of Vac-con unit with new decals and labels.
16. Complete Paint of chassis (town emblems replaced by town upon return).
17. Complete New Unit Accessory Package, 20' of 8" aluminum suction tubes w/clamps, leader hose, tiger tail guide, (2) standard cleaning nozzles, skid pipe, and hydrant wrench.
18. All items set to factory settings and Service inspection completed.
19. Vac-con unit will have a New Unit standard warranty (6) six months. Parts and Labor.
20. Transportation to and from repair facility to be included. Truck chassis will be in "road worthy" condition, with repairs to chassis the Boro responsibility.
21. Telescopic Assembly tubes need to be replaced.

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22. Include a new pendant control.
23. Boom Tie-Down System needs to be rebuilt.
